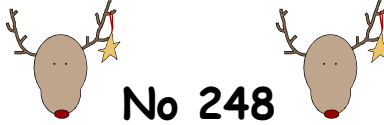

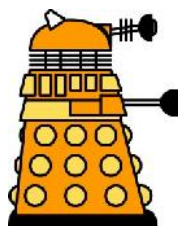

TV/Film related Toy & Collectables Sale

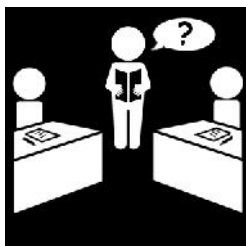

Christmas tree recycling



After this year's festivities have ended, Sevenoaks District Council can collect and recycle your real Christmas tree for free throughout January. The Council will collect trees with a trunk of up to 90mm (3.5 inches) in diameter with its Garden Waste Collection Service until Friday 29th January. Simply leave your tree by the boundary of your property, where you'd usually put your refuse and recycling sacks, by 7am on the day the Council's Garden Waste Collection service visits your road. If you're not sure when the service is scheduled for your area then visit www.sevenoaks.gov.uk/collectiondays and search for your road name. The good news is that all the trees will be turned into environmentally-friendly compost. For this reason the Council cannot take trees that are decorated or in pots or

stands. If your tree is too big for this service, you can take it to one of Kent County Council's Household Waste Recycling sites. Call KCC on 03000 417373 for locations and opening times or visit www.kent.gov.uk.

Otford Village Memorial Hall - Refurbishment Progress Report

As many of you are aware the Village Hall is not owned by Otford Parish Council, but is a Registered Charity owned and managed by Trustees who represent many of the local organisations who use the Village Hall. Funding to operate and maintain the building and facilities of the Hall is generated by the income it receives from letting it out. However, for major work it is necessary to raise funds by applying for grants and appealing to local residents and societies. It is thanks to the generosity of everyone who has donated and given grants that we have now funding in place to complete Phase 1 of the project and work commenced on 28th September.

Progress to date is:

- Completed the replacement of our inefficient and unreliable Gas Boiler. This has been replaced by 2 highly efficient Gas Boilers each with their own pumps so that if one fails the other can continue to keep the temperature at an acceptable level.
- Completed the refurbishment of the Disabled Toilet and it now complies with all legal requirements, is finished to a high standard and is easier to clean.
- Completed the Men's Toilets in the Main Hall.
- Completed the Ladies Toilets in the Main Hall.
- The Club Room Toilets, Changing Room Toilets, The Showers themselves will be completed by 31/01/16.

We are now starting to apply for grants to enable us to replace The Club Room Kitchen, install a Hearing Loop in the Club Room, and renovate The Hope Room to make it easier to clean and more sound proof.

To enable us to do this we need to raise from all sources about (excluding Grants) another £12,000.
