#### Chairman's Report



Much of my Council over the past month has been taken up with the implications of the Northern Sevenoaks Masterplan. For those

of you who have missed this visionary plan, it deals with the regeneration and development of Northern Sevenoaks over the next 15-20 years. Unfortunately, among other notable omissions, the consultants have failed to take into account the infrastructure constraints including the increased traffic through Bat & Ball junction that will be created by large numbers of new houses north of the A25, as well as the additional demands for school places and health facilities. These will inevitable have a significant impact on the neighbouring parishes of Riverhead, Dunton Green, Seal and, of course, Otford. In addition to increased traffic on the A225 between Otford and Bat & Ball, there will be pressure to extend the Vestry Estate northwards into the Green Belt that separates Otford from Sevenoaks. This is unacceptable and the Council will resist it resolutely! On 6th June, Otford Parish Council hosted a well-attended meeting in the Village Hall for councillors and residents of all the parishes that border Northern Sevenoaks. Although neither Sevenoaks Town Council nor the consultants who drafted the plan were formally represented (although they had been invited),

several Town councillors attended and spoke. In summing up, I noted that those present seemed to agree that there was a need for a plan - but that it had to be the right plan. The current draft of the Masterplan appears to be impractical and STC need help to deal with the infrastructure issues. To this end Otford Parish Council has formally requested that it should be included in the new group/committee to look at the infrastructure issues and we have every hope that the other neighbouring parishes will also ask to be included. You can find the report of the meeting on Otford.net or pick up a printed copy from the Parish Office. This will be an ongoing project so please keep in touch.



I would remind you that every meeting on the Council and its committees starts with a ten minute public forum to which you are invited. This is your Parish and your Council and we want

you to be involved.


Our next Social Gathering will be at The Woodman on **Monday 17th July** from 7.30 pm.
